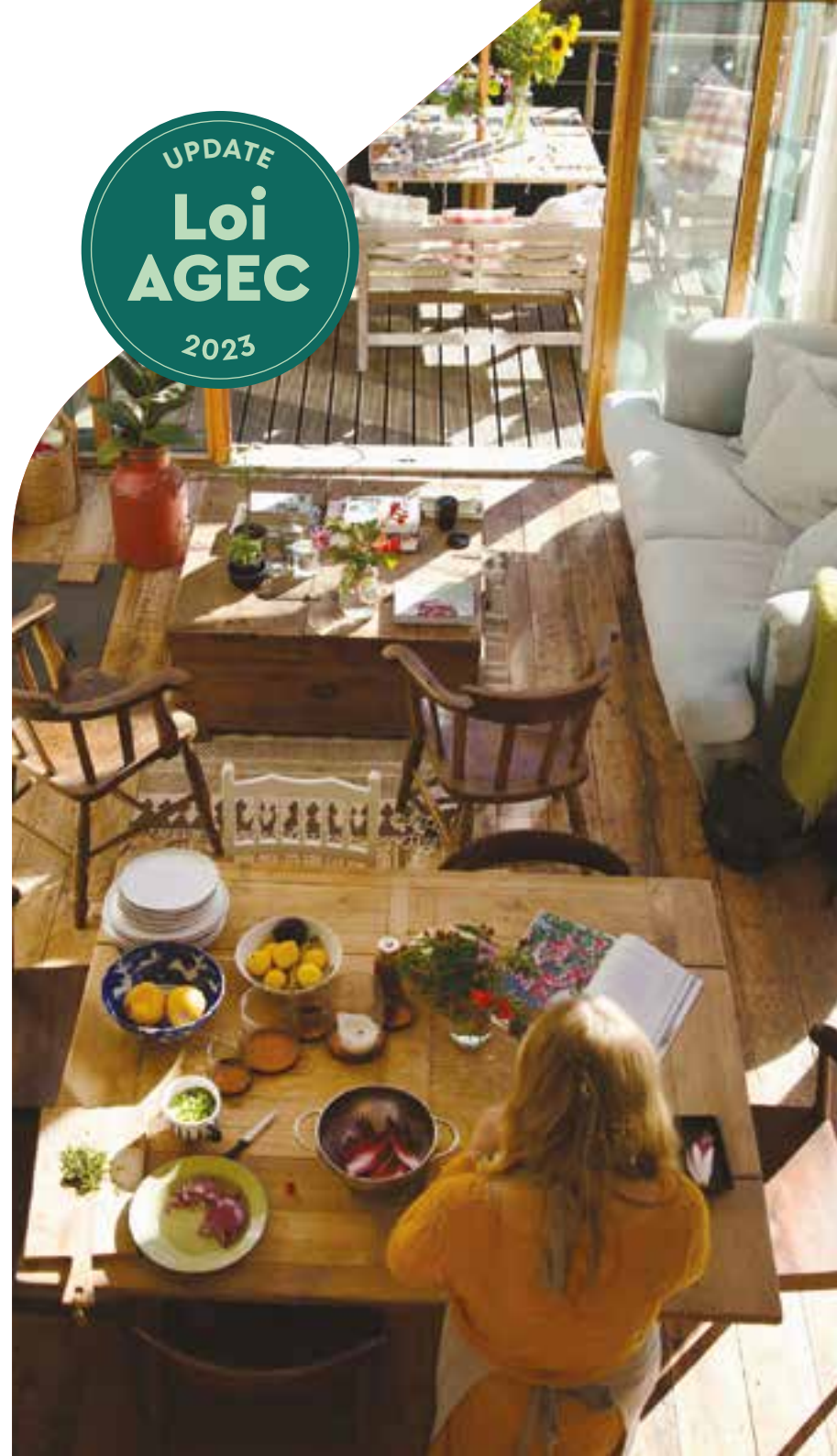

Since 2013, we have been striving to provide sustainable solutions and reduce the environmental impact **of furniture, furnishing, and fit-out items.**

In this guide, you will find an updated presentation of our services for recycling **furniture and bedding**, in compliance with the regulations arising from the French Anti-Waste Act for a Circular Economy, **adopted in February 2020.**

An extension of the product scope to include decorative textile items (curtains, net curtains, removable mats and carpets, including event carpets, etc.) has also been added to the 2023 edition.

A further update is already being planned, with the implementation of the repair fund and the reuse fund.

Let's keep working together towards **ZERO waste from furniture and bedding.**

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1 Overview of the Services Contract

The Services Contract presented in this guide covers all your dealings with Ecomaison in relation to the marketing of furniture items.

Why is a Services Contract needed?

For our members: manufacturers, distributors, and fitters

The scope of products concerned covers all furniture, furnishing, and fit-out items, without exception¹.

Since 21 december 2022², this scope has been expanded to include a new category: decorative textile items.

The eco-fee rates, differentiated according to recyclability, have remained unchanged since 2020.

The unique identifier issued by ADEME is sent to you by Ecomaison and is accessible in your Services Area. The display procedures in your General Terms and Conditions of Sale and legal notices are specified on [page 29](#).

KEY POINTS



You must implement the eco-fee rates

The rates have applied since 1 January 2020 and have remained unchanged. The declaring marketer implements the updated rate and product code, then the eco-fee is applied identically at each stage of the product distribution chain, through to the end customer. New rates [page 12](#)



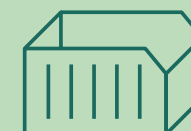
You must display your unique identifier and the eco-fee

You must include the **unique identifier** in your General Terms and Conditions of Sale and/or any other contractual document communicated to the buyer, as proof of your compliance and commitment to the channel. **TRIMAN sorting signage** for the product at the end of its life must also be affixed on the products. Finally, the French Anti-Waste Act for a Circular Economy has extended the display of the eco-fee until 2026. More useful information [page 42](#)



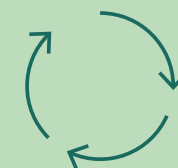
You must implement the regulations regarding the recovery and donation of unsold goods

Since 1 January 2022, you must offer free recovery of your customers' products, under certain conditions. You must also donate all unsold products to associations/charities, and track your donations. Further assistance: [pages 58 et 59](#)



You earn premiums for the incorporation of recycled materials

Your contribution to recycling is rewarded: by incorporating recycled materials into your products, **you can earn premiums** in the form of financial allowances. Overview of the services [pages 56 et 57](#)





Products concerned

Furniture, furnishing, fit-out, and decorative textile items



Storage & fit-out components

Cupboards, storage units and fit-out components (custom or standard), cabinets and dressing tables, wardrobes, walk-in wardrobe components, doors (sliding or standard), accessories and coverings, storage boxes and units, furnishing panels, furnishing covers and textiles, etc.



Bathroom

Bathroom furniture, hardware, and other accessories, etc.



Kitchen

Upper and lower kitchen units, panels and doors, tabletops and worktops, bottle racks, cutlery trays, etc.



Lounge and living room furniture

Tables, chairs, seats, sofas, cushions, bar furniture, nesting tables, credenzas, sideboards, etc.



Technical and office furniture

Desks, chairs, drawer units on wheels, industrial compartment drawer units, visual or acoustic separation screens, etc.



Outdoor and garden furniture

Panels cut to size in all materials, panels, workbenches, garden tables and chairs, garden seats, sofas, and chairs, camping tables and mattresses, swing chairs, etc.



Furnishing hardware and accessories

Racks, brackets, doorknobs, door handles, wardrobe rods, rails, sliding drawers, shelves, etc.



Childcare

Cots, drawers, high chairs, etc.



Bedding and bedroom furniture

Bed bases, mattresses, beds, headboards, duvets, pillows, bed legs, bed-base slats, bedside tables, storage boxes, etc.



Decorative textile items

Curtains, net curtains, rugs and mats, doormats, removable event carpets, etc.



Extension of the scope to include decorative textile items

Decorative textile items



Ecomaison received accreditation on 21 December 2022 for the decorative textile category, the twelfth category in the furniture items channel, for products intended for individuals and professionals.

When will the procedures for this channel be applicable?

You must **apply the eco-fee to the products concerned as of 1 April 2023**, on your invoices.

This eco-fee is visible in addition to the price of the product, see [page 46](#).

It must be declared to Ecomaison, in accordance with the contractual provisions, on a quarterly or annual basis.

What does this category cover?



Decorative rugs

Rugs (high or low pile, bedside, faux fur, etc.), faux animal skin rugs, carpet rugs, etc.



Functional mats and doormats

Mats (hall, stairs, non-slip, hygienic, anti-fatigue, dust-control, etc.), doormats, underlays, etc.



Removable event carpets

Event carpets for exhibition stands or aisles, removable professional or acoustic carpets, etc.



Interior blinds, curtains and net curtains

Skylight, roller, pleated blinds, curtains, tension fabrics, tapestries, wall hangings, etc.



Small decorative textile items

Macramé, hanging decorative textile items, decorative textile garlands, etc.



Hanging accessories

Rods, rings, hanging strips, rod buttons, clothes rails, corner sets, etc.



Decorative wall frames

Decorative canvas to hang, kakemono, vertical signs with textile, painted canvas, textile decorative with their chassis

2 Applicable rates

The eco-fee funds the collection, reuse, and recycling of used furniture and bedding all over France.

The eco-fee rates for 2023 are unchanged and have remained stable since 2020.

Take a look at the rates for each family of products and examples of implementation in pictures.

In the 2023 version of this guide, you will also find rates for decorative textile items.



Furniture, furnishing and fit-out items

The rates take account of the recyclability of materials used in the products.

Products mainly composed of wood and wood derivatives (fibreboard, alveolar board, or other wood/plant mix panels) and products made from metal or wood/metal mixes, fall under the “Standard - wood, wood derivatives, and metal” rate. Among these products, those composed of **more than 75% particleboard, solid wood, and/or metal, without elements disruptive to recycling*** may benefit from a reduced eco-fee.

The least easily recyclable products, mainly composed of plastic, glass, ceramics, composite, resin, stone, textiles, or other mixed materials, fall under the “Standard - all materials” rate applied at the highest eco-fee level.

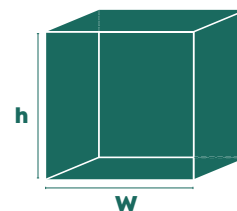

Rates incl. VAT for wood and wood-derivative panels and shelves, whole and cut to size

A distinction is to be made between:

Shelves, wood and/or wood-derivative panels with decorative additions (melamine, veneer, etc.);

Untreated panels, wood and/or wood-derivative panels with no decorative additions (melamine, veneer, etc.). The latter category includes three types.

► **Pre-cut untreated panels**: products that are already cut, available off-the-shelf (such as shelves).

► **Uncut untreated panels**: products that are not cut (minimum standard dimensions: 250×120 or 125cm), available off-the-shelf or via order-and-collect.

► **Untreated panels, cut to size**: products cut to customer's specifications in the store's cutting workshop.

Seating

The rates apply according to the weight of the seat, and take into account the presence or absence of padding.

Seats without padding fall under the “*Seats without padding*” rate, regardless of the materials and structure of these seats. Among these products, seats composed of **more than 75% certified solid wood and/or metal** may benefit from a reduced eco-fee.

Seats with padding and inflatable seats fall under the “*Seats with padding*” rate, regardless of the materials and structure of these seats.

- bed bases with padding.

For slatted frames and bed bases without padding, bed bases **composed of more than 75% solid wood and/or metal** may benefit from a reduced eco-fee.

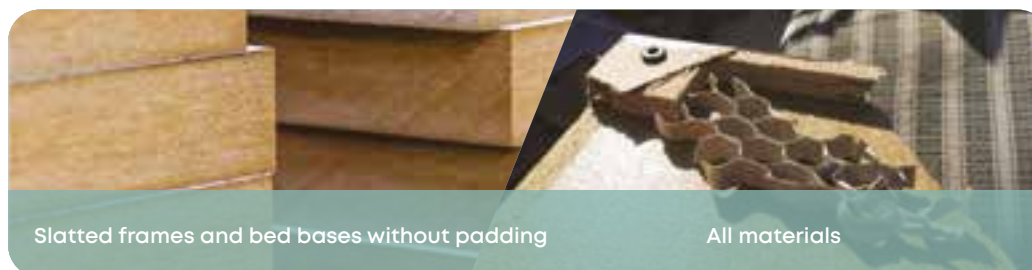

Decorative textiles



The three criteria for calculating the eco-fee are the recyclability of the materials, the type of products, and the weight of these products.

The various categories of decorative textile items have different objectives in terms of collection, recycling, and reuse, which have been included in the specifications for the EPR approach. The codification of products subject to an eco-fee has been structured to comply with this distinction. The prices for this 12th category of the furniture channel are valid until the end of 2023.

Simplified pricing scales for small producers

In order to streamline the declaration process for producers marketing small quantities of products, Ecomaison offers a simplified, flat-rate system.

Who does this concern?

Any company placing fewer than 1,000 items per year on the market, subject to a total weight of less than 15 tonnes.

What does Ecomaison offer?

The **flat-rate scheme operates in sets of 10 units** (regardless of the number of products placed on the market) and is based on the highest bracket of the eco-fee scale per product category. The producer therefore does not require exhaustive data on the product to make their declaration (such as the sub-category, weight, or material of the products).

How does it work?

Producers eligible for the flat-rate scheme will be able to avail of this simplified procedure when making their quarterly and annual declarations. At the beginning of each financial year, the producer will determine their reporting procedures: actual or flat-rate. The simplified scheme is only available for actual declarations.

This simplified system is also **available for declarations by marketplaces on behalf of their third-party sellers**. This marketplace declaration is only made on a quarterly basis.

3 Display rules

The inclusion of required information ensures regulatory compliance.

In 2022, the implementation of the French Anti-Waste Act for a Circular Economy revised display requirements with sorting signage associated with the updated TRIMAN logo and a new unique identifier.

In 2023, marketers must inform consumers of certain **environmental qualities and characteristics** relating to the products sold.

Learn how to present this information to your customers.



Required information: unique identifiers



How has the unique identifier changed?

Since 1 January 2022, it has been composed of the former SYDEREP number (FR123456), followed by an underscore, a two-digit code representing the channel, and a random four-letter code.

Example

FR123456_10ABCD

This unique identifier is required by all marketers, as it certifies that the company is enrolled in the French national register of producers managed by ADEME. It is sent to you by Ecomaison and is available in your Services Area.

► N.B. Article L.541-9-5 of the French Environmental Code provides that in the event of non-compliance with the regulatory obligations relating to the unique identifier, an administrative fine of up to €30,000 may be imposed.

► N.B. If you are a manufacturer, distributor or fitter, for several extended producer responsibility (REP) sectors, you will need to provide all unique identifiers in your general sales documents **or, failing that, in any other contractual document.**

This requirement also concerns marketplaces. They are also required to keep a register of third-party sellers, along with their identifiers. Should third-party sellers not fulfil their obligations, the marketplaces themselves will have to pay the eco-fee in place of these third-party sellers.

How can you ensure regulatory compliance?

The regulatory compliance of marketers is regularly checked by both scheduled and unscheduled audits.

This unique identifier must appear in the General Terms and Conditions of Sale, or failing that, in any other contractual document.

Ecomaison provides you with required information templates to attach to your documents: website, product sheets, guides, etc.

In the General Terms and Conditions of Sale

“[name of company] is enrolled in the French National Register of Marketers of Furniture Items under number FR123456_10ABCD.

This number certifies that [name of company], as a member of Ecomaison, is in compliance with its regulatory requirements under Article 541-10 and 541-10-1 10° of the French Environmental Code.”

On invoices

“Regulatory compliance with the French National Register of Marketers of Furniture Items under number FR123456_10ABCD.”

Eco-fee display requirements

How must you communicate about the eco-fee?

Companies that sell furniture, furnishing, or fit-out items must display the eco-fee on their sales documents:

- **For sales between professionals**, the eco-fee, in the form of rates with the appropriate explanations and/or the unit amount allocated to each product, **must be shown in catalogues and on invoices**.
- **For sales to individuals and professionals**, its display is also compulsory **next to the total sale price of the product, whether in sales outlets or on websites**, on receipts, on price tags, in catalogues, and on invoices.

The term **eco-fee**, or the alternative **eco-contribution**, may be used interchangeably in your communication materials.

It is also advisable to offer further explanations to your customers, to enable them to understand the purpose of this eco-fee.

► N.B. The requirement to display the eco-fee is defined under [Article L. 541-10-21](#) of the French Environmental Code. [Article R. 543-256-1](#) of the French Environmental Code provides for an administrative fine (3rd class offence, for an amount of €450) for any failure to correctly display the eco-fee.

TRIMAN sorting signage

Since 2015, **it has been mandatory to affix the TRIMAN logo** in order to inform the consumer that the product is subject to sorting requirements. The French Anti-Waste Act for a Circular Economy now requires this to be supplemented by channel-specific sorting instructions. These two elements make up the sorting signage.

This sorting signage consists of the TRIMAN logo and information on procedures for sorting or transferring waste resulting from the product, and must be provided in close proximity to the product:

- on the product;
- or on the product's packaging;
- or in other documentation provided with the product.

Provision of information on the website remains possible, but does not replace specification on one of the three items mentioned above.

■ **N.B.** After this date, the TRIMAN logo and the information must appear on the products placed on the market, **EXCEPT** for products that meet the following two conditions:

- the product was manufactured or imported prior to the date on which the regulations entered into force
- the manufacturer or importer transferred this product before the stock disposal deadline.

If the various components of the product are subject to different sorting procedures (packaging, electronic equipment, etc.), these procedures must be detailed for each of the components.

► ENTRY INTO FORCE

As of 15 December 2021 for the furniture sector.

► STOCK DISPOSAL DEADLINE

12 months authorised, until 15 December 2022.

► EXTENDED DEADLINE

Until 15 June 2023 for products manufactured or imported before 15 December 2022¹.

TRIMAN

This is mandatory and cannot be dissociated from the signage.



INSTRUCTIONS

You must present to consumers the three solutions that will allow them to give used furniture and bedding a second life.

MESSAGES

The message must guide the consumer towards the two options available to them to dispose of their products, i.e. donating or recycling.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF WASTE

This ADEME website provides sorting solutions and explains what becomes of each type of waste. Including this information is mandatory.

► N.B. **Article L.541-9-4** of the French Environmental Code provides that in the event of non-compliance with the regulatory obligations relating to sorting signage, an administrative fine of up to €3,000 for a natural person or €15,000 for a legal entity may be imposed.

Exceptions

Products for professionals

If your products are used for professional purposes and are not similar to those held by households, then they are not affected by the new sorting signage.

Small products

- **Surface area between 10cm² and 20cm²:** the sorting information can be dematerialised, but affixing of the TRIMAN logo remains mandatory.
- **Surface area smaller than 10cm²:** the TRIMAN instructions and the sorting information may be entirely dematerialised.
- **Specific provisions for cylindrical or spherical products or packaging:** these surface areas of 10 and 20cm² are increased to 20 and 40cm².



Consumer information on environmental qualities and characteristics



The French Anti-Waste Act for a Circular Economy seeks to improve consumer awareness, by informing consumers about the environmental characteristics of purchased products, particularly by means of physical or electronic display, or any other appropriate process.

Who does this concern?

All **producers, importers, distributors, or other marketers** in France, including **online resellers**, in decreasing increments based on turnover and products placed on the market.

What information must be provided for the furniture sector?

► Incorporation of recycled material

Defined as the overall proportion, by weight, of recycled materials.

Information to be included: **“Product containing at least [x%] recycled materials”**.

► Presence of hazardous substances

Concerns substances identified by the Decree of 1 October 2021, on the list of substances that are candidates for authorisation maintained by the European Chemicals Agency, under the REACH Regulation.

Where present in a concentration greater than 0.1% of product mass, the statement **“Contains a hazardous substance: [name of substance]”** is mandatory.

► Recyclability

Characterised by five cumulative conditions related to collection, sorting, absence of substances disrupting sorting, percentage of material recycled from waste, and industrial scale of the recycling channel.

Required information: **“Mainly recyclable product”** for a product that is more than 50% recyclable or **“Entirely recyclable product”** for a product that is more than 95% recyclable.

Ecomaison provides a dedicated tool for calculating the recyclability of furniture items.

► * N.B. [decree no. 2022-748](#) of 29 april 2022



What is the application schedule?

As of 1 January 2023, the consumer information obligation will gradually come into force for relevant businesses, in decreasing increments based on turnover.

1 January 2023

DISPLAY OBLIGATION

- Annual turnover **greater than €50 million**
- **Over 25,000 products** concerned, placed on the market in 2023
- However, this is not applicable to products for which the last unit is placed on the market between 1 January and 31 March 2023.

1 January 2024

DISPLAY OBLIGATION

- Annual turnover **greater than €20 million**
- **Over 10,000 products** concerned, placed on the market in 2024.

1 January 2025

DISPLAY OBLIGATION

- Annual turnover **greater than €10 million**
- **Over 10,000 products** concerned, placed on the market in 2025.

Premiums for the incorporation of recycled materials

You can earn premiums for the incorporation of raw materials recycled from used furniture or mattresses into your products.

Who does this concern?

French manufacturers or ordering parties for the manufacture of furniture, furnishing, or fit-out items.

What does Ecomaison offer?

A **financial allowance** for your company, in the form of premiums, calculated on the basis of raw materials recycled from furniture waste incorporated into products sold in France.

How does it work?

Every six months, you send Ecomaison:

- information on your overall supply;
- a breakdown of supplies per supplier incorporating used wood or foam recycled by Ecomaison.

Ecomaison then calculates your premiums based on the incorporation of recycled materials, for payment of the financial allowance. The statements will be checked, in cooperation with the suppliers, before payment of the allowance.

What is the amount?

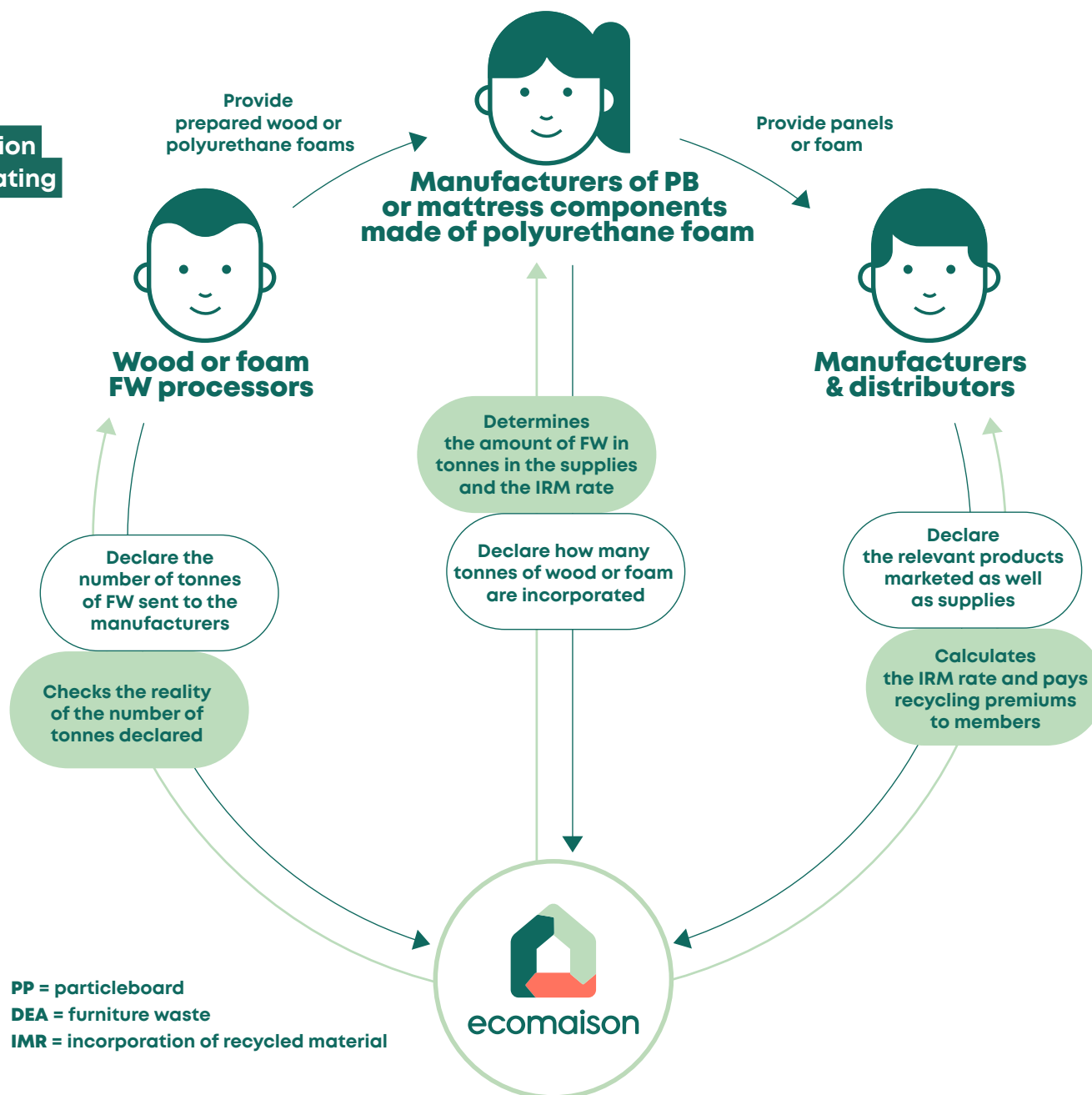
These premiums are proportional to the weight of recycled materials incorporated into your marketed products, calculated by Ecomaison, according to the scale applicable in 2022:

- **“wood” recycled material: €40/tonne** of wood sourced from the Ecomaison channel and incorporated into your products;
- **“foam” recycled material: €50/tonne** of polyurethane foam sourced from the Ecomaison channel and used to manufacture mattresses.

Collection and recovery of used furniture



Ecomaison offers you recovery and collection procedures for the disposal of your used furniture and bedding, thereby guaranteeing that they are recycled.

Who does this concern?

Distribution chains, independent stores, networks, franchises, concessions selling furniture, furnishing, or fit-out items, and distance sellers.

What do you need to do?

Since 1 January 2022, you are required to **implement free recovery for your customers** in accordance with Articles L. 541-10-8 and R. 541-158 to R. 541-166 of the French Environmental Code.

The recovery conditions implemented must be **communicated to the customer, before any sale is concluded, in a legible and easily accessible manner.**

What does Ecomaison offer?

- A **self-assessment tool** for determining the type of recovery to be implemented, giving you access to the appropriate services and information;
- A **GPS map** of Ecomaison's 5,000 partner collection points across France, for your customers and your teams;
- A **map of local collection points** for your customers, for recovery of their small items;
- **Collection containers** for used furniture and bedding;
- **Bags** for the recovery of used bedding;
- **Communication materials** (posters, seller memos, leaflets) and digital tools, including recovery stipulations, for customer information.

■ N.B. Recovery is mandatory for decorative textile items as of 1 January 2023.



How does it work?

You can choose the free collection services suited to your obligations: a dedicated container, access to local collection points, etc.

- **1:1 recovery:** you recover a used product from your customer, similar to the one purchased.
- **1:0 recovery:** you recover used products similar to those you sell, with no purchase requirement.

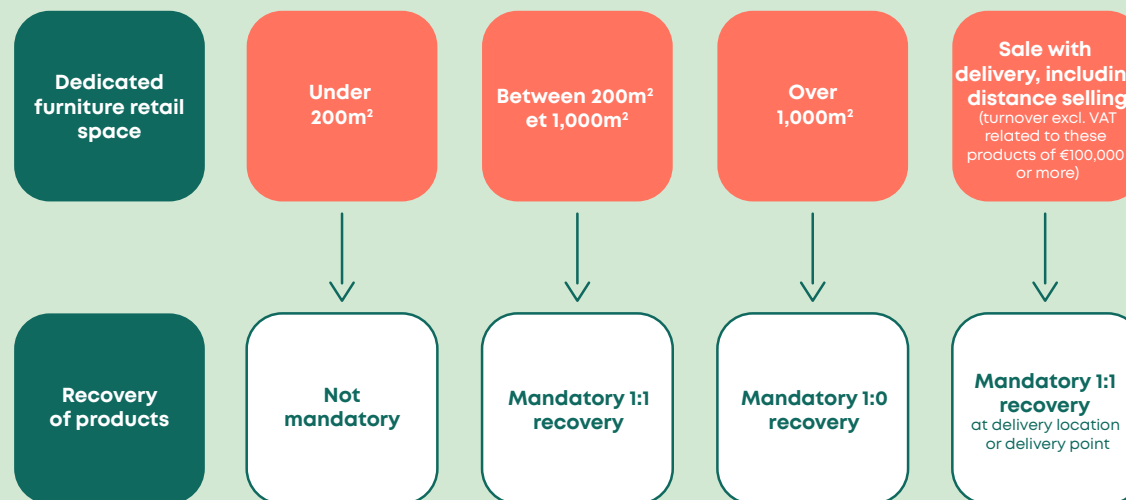

When you part with unsold, discontinued, or other new products, we help you forge new partnerships with associations and charities working to reuse them in a socially conscious way.

Who does this concern?

Since 1 January 2022, manufacturers, distributors, and marketplaces have **an obligation to donate their unsold products**, in accordance with Article L. 541-15-8 of the French Environmental Code.

What does Ecomaison offer?

► Via the Donation platform, Ecomaison connects its members with associations and charities working to promote socially responsible reuse, **in order to facilitate the donation of unsold items, spare parts, after-sales service returns, and display models**. It also makes it possible **to track offers of donations that have not found any takers, before recycling them**.

► Help **establishing partnerships between the company and associations and charities**.

Note: unsold products donated or sent for recycling are subject to **payment of the eco-fee to Ecomaison**.

How does it work?

The **Donation platform** can be accessed via the Services Area. In just a few clicks, create your classified ad and make contact with interested charitable associations.

For the **establishment of long-term partnerships**, Ecomaison identifies Social and Circular Economy organisations similar to your brand with which to connect.

Assistance with the waste prevention and eco-design plan



To reduce the environmental impact of furniture, you must implement a waste prevention and eco-design plan. Ecomaison provides tools to make it easier for you to draw up this plan.

Who does this concern?

All marketer members who design, manufacture, or distribute furniture, furnishing, and fit-out items.

What are your obligations?

You are required to draw up and implement **a waste prevention and eco-design plan intended to reduce the use of non-renewable resources, increase the usage of recycled materials, and enhance the recyclability of your products**. This individual plan must be revised every five years*.

How does it work?

You implement an eco-design approach in your company, and Ecomaison helps you to promote it.

What does Ecomaison offer?

- Tools to facilitate the drawing up of individual or collective waste prevention and eco-design plans.
- An online **eco-design self-assessment tool**, to evaluate your company's maturity in this area.
- A **guide for selecting materials** and designing products.

Regulatory requirements for marketplaces



Since 1 January 2022, marketplaces are **responsible** and are required to provide or contribute to **waste prevention and management**¹. In the event that a third-party seller has not fulfilled its Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) obligations and the marketplace does not have the corresponding supporting documents, the marketplace is required to fulfil, in the place of the third-party seller, their obligations for the channels concerned, including:

- becoming a member,
- declaring to Ecomaison,
- paying the eco-fee.

Which companies are concerned?

Any company that uses an electronic interface – **marketplace**, platform, portal, or similar – **to remotely sell or deliver products falling under the EPR principle** on behalf of a third party.

Regulatory requirements for marketplaces

How can you ensure regulatory compliance?

1 Become a member of Ecomaison

Sign the **Ecomaison Services Contract** to obtain your **unique identifier** and set up an account to make your **quarterly** declarations.

2 Keep a register of third-party sellers

As a marketplace, you are **required to keep a register of your third-party sellers**, with **their details, unique identifiers, quantities placed on the market** by category (using Ecomaison codes), and their **recovery procedures** (see [page 54](#)).

3 Apply the eco-fee

If the third-party seller places products without the marketplace having the marketer's unique identifier number, the marketplace must determine the product code and eco-fee applicable to the product and then insert its unique identifier.

4 Declare the eco-fee

At the end of each quarter, the marketplace submits its **declaration file in the Services Area**. An overall invoice is then issued and a payment is made within the contractual deadlines. At the same time, a summary invoice for the amount to be paid is forwarded electronically to the marketplace.

5 Offer a recovery service

The marketplace is bound by a further **obligation to provide information on recovery options for furniture and bedding**, as well as products in other relevant EPR channels (see [page 62](#)).

What tools should be used to apply the product code and eco-fee?

As a marketplace, you can apply the eco-fee pricing scale using the code generator. In addition, **a simplified list of fewer than 100 codes** may be provided to you, **by contacting our teams**. With this handy tool, you can easily apply the (increased) rate where information may be missing regarding detailed product characteristics.

FAQs

1. Am I a marketer?

You are a marketer:

- 1. if you are a **manufacturer in France**, OR
- 2. if you **import furniture, furnishing, and fit-out items in France**, OR
- 3. if you **distribute products under your own brand**, OR
- 4. as a **wholesaler, distributor, or website based abroad** and selling directly to individuals in France.

2. How do I know if a product is within the scope?

All furniture, furnishing, and fit-out items, without exclusion, are concerned, so long as they form part of the fit-out of a personal residence, commercial premises, or a public reception space, for the purposes of seating, sleeping, storage, or offering a counter top or worktop.

This is true regardless of the material, whether the product is finished, semi-finished, or simply a component, for all types of furniture: kitchen and bathroom, bedding and bedroom, DIY/home decoration/garden, lounge and living room, childcare, sports and leisure, hardware and accessories, technical and office furniture. 3. How to declare the eco-fee

All declaration services, along with your information (accounts, contacts, firms, users) are in the **Services Area**, where you can:

- prepare your declaration using the codification tools,
- find the eco-fee amounts,
- import your declaration according to the required format.

4. If my marketing total is less than €100,000 excl. VAT per year, are there simplified declaration procedures?

YES: French tradespeople, subject to evidence of enrolment in the Trade and Craft Register, are exempt from declaring their marketing information if their turnover is less than €100,000 for the previous year. A financial disclosure must then be made annually, on the dates of the marketing declaration, signed by your accountant.

5. If my marketing total is less than €500,000 excl. VAT per year, are there simplified declaration procedures?

YES: You join, you declare your turnover, and you benefit from simplified procedures for declaring your marketing information, once a year, either on an actual basis, or as a fixed sum equal to **1.6% excl. VAT of your marketing total**.

6. What are the changes to the Services Contract in 2022?

- Display of your store on our GPS map,
- Pooling of skips between professionals,
- Provision of new containers,
- Option of leaving one producer responsibility organisation to join another one.

7. How do I certify my marketing information?

The member marketer **certifies to Ecomaison the veracity of their declarations**, including all details of sales of furniture items marketed within the last calendar year, via the **Services Area**.

If the amount of the declarations exceeds €200,000 excl. VAT per year, a statement approved by a **statutory auditor or, failing that, by a chartered accountant**, is requested.

The certificate must include **the total quantities and contributions** for the previous year, and it must be submitted to Ecomaison no later than the end of June of the following year.
